



## Official Memo: Announcing Deactivation of EmployeNC Job Posting Consortium

Dear Valued Employer:

Effective immediately, the NC Community College Consortium formerly known as “**EmployeNC**” is no longer active in its current group consortium format. Our primary reasons for deactivating our consortium stem primarily from our college membership decreasing to only five North Carolina Community Colleges, resulting in significantly increased geographic distance from one another, making the consortium model less effective than initially intended.

For the time being, each of our member colleges plans to continue utilizing the same software that has driven our individual college employer and student databases (CSO, Inc. Interfase). If this ever changes in the future for any of us, we will let you know via our own individual database’s messaging tools. So for now, what does all this mean for you? Very simply, the following:

- Versus a single sign-in page, you will now need to visit each of our respective posting links, as soon as possible, to quickly create a new, separate password with each of our registration links. Your current contact Username (your individual company e-mail), will remain the same. Moving forward, please post your intended vacancies and opportunities at each college’s individual posting link.
- Your initial registration with the EmployeNC consortium page, as well as any currently active job postings, registrations for upcoming on-campus recruiting, career fair events, etc., remains active within each college’s respective databases. You should **NOT** need to re-post them or re-schedule upcoming events with any of our member colleges.
- Each of us understands and expects that local NC employers may actively focus their recruiting efforts on their more geographically local community college service area(s) without such a continuing consortium. So, some of us will likely continue to reach out and send individualized messages to you to aid further development and maintenance of our relationships with all of you. We certainly welcome and encourage your reciprocation and continued active posting of opportunities and on-campus efforts with each of our individual colleges. We appreciate your actively recruiting our students and graduates who meet your needs for highly skilled workers.
- Since this transition requires each of us to make some technical changes in our own respective databases, there may be occasions where our sites don’t behave perfectly. On the next page, you will find a table with each of our colleges’ respective contact and direct links to allow you to make this transition with us as smoothly as possible. Following your review of this announcement, please begin to contact us individually with any questions/concerns about posting with that respective college.
